

A bid opening was held at the Town of Ballston Town Hall in the Meeting Room at 3 p.m. on November 9, 2016.

The purpose of the bid was to request proposals from consulting and engineering firms to provide design and the construction services for a sewer system around the entire Ballston Lake as approved by the local referendum held by the Town of Ballston on October 12, 2015.

Present were Councilman Goslin, Dick Doyle, Drew Hamelink, Dave and Ann Pierce, Jim DiPasquale, Kathryn Serra of C.T. Male, Sean Doty of The Chazen Companies, Ed Hernandez of Adirondack Mountain Engineering, and Carol Gumienny, Town Clerk.

The Clerk opened the bids and they were read aloud by Dick Doyle. The bids were as follows:

Mr. Doyle stated the next step is to review all the bids to be certain they all have met the requirements stated in the request for proposals (RFP). The committee will choose from the applicants and have them return at a later date to do a short presentation and answer questions from the Committee. A decision should be made in approximately one month who the bid will be awarded to.

Councilman Goslin wanted to thank the people who came out today to listen to the bids and thanked all the bidders for participating in the RFP.
