David Pearce asked what was the agreement the Town Board made when the water district was extended up Goode Street. Counsel stated there was a resolution to not extend water in the agricultural district. There was no agreement or law; it was a resolution.

Jeremy Knight stated some history to the Board about water on Goode Street as no current members were on the Board at that time. The water extension for Goode Street was shut down twice by residents to extend water into the ag district. His father filed an Article 78 with the Town to address concerns of bringing water in the ag district and the new construction. The Board, at the time, ran the water up Goode Street due to a public necessity. The resolution was passed during this time not to extent water into the ag district. Currently, Mr. Knight has seen documentation from a lawyer which states binding legislation is still in effect after the water district consolidation was approved by the Board last year.

The public hearing was closed at 6:05 p.m.
