



TOWN OF BALLSTON SPECIAL MEETING
AUGUST 31, 2010

A special meeting was held by the Town Board of the Town of Ballston on Tuesday evening, August 31, 2010. Members present were Supervisor Patricia Southworth, Councilwoman Mary Beth Hynes, Councilman Jeremy Knight, and Councilwoman Kimberly Ireland. Also present were Town Attorney Murry Brower and Town Clerk Muriel Swatling. Absent was Councilman Timothy Szczepaniak.

Supervisor Southworth called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The first item on the Agenda was to consider approving the amended Saratoga County Water Authority Contract Addendum.

10-110: A motion was made by Mary Beth Hynes and seconded by Jeremy Knight to table resolution 10-110 to approve the amended Saratoga County Water Authority Contract Addendum. Roll Call: Ayes – all; Noes – none. Carried.

A motion was made by Kimberly Ireland and seconded by Mary Beth Hynes that General Fund bills #385 through #432 totaling \$36,467.13; Highway Fund bills #266 through #327 totaling \$266,845.32; Water District bills #64 through #71 totaling \$16,426.70; Park District No. 1 bills #22 through #32 totaling \$3,021.85; and Gravel Pit bills #9 through #14 totaling \$10,689.35 be paid. Roll Call: Ayes – all; Noes – none. Carried.

David Pierce wrote a letter to the Town Board asking that the Town Board consider enacting a local law prohibiting the use of fertilizer containing phosphorus and told the Town Board if they had any questions concerning the letter to please ask.

Paul Simpson said he took a look at the floors in the Community Room and since they have been rewaxed, they look brand new.

A motion was made by Mary Beth Hynes and seconded by Jeremy Knight to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call: Ayes – all; Noes – none. Carried.
